The itinerary for the 2007 Huntingdon County Queen Pageant which is scheduled for Saturday July 14, 2007 will be as follows:

Arrival time will be 12:30-1:00 p.m. Contestants will arrive at the Singer's Gap Church along Route 747, signs will be posted for the contestants to follow. **Dress should be casual, but please no jeans.** Each contestant should bring all items needed to get ready for the pageant: such as crowns, gown, make-up, sash, jewelry, etc. (Crowns may be worn during the interviews.) All family and friends must leave after contestants are signed in.

1:00-3:00 P.M. - Personal interviews will take place with the judges.

3:00-3:30 P.M. - Light refreshments will be served.

**3:30 PM-5:00 PM** - Contestants will dress for parade and pageant. Only one person may come and assist from 4:00 PM until 5:00 PM.

5:00 PM - Transportation needs to be at the church to pick up contestants for the parade. All companies are responsible for making arrangements for their Queen's transportation.

Colonial Florist of Mount Union has been selected to make the flower deliveries prior to the parade. This is for anyone who wishes to order flowers here. Please contact Colonial Florist by July 2, 2007 if you choose to use this florist. When placing your order, specify what company they are for and that they are for the Queen Pageant. Arrangements have already been made for the flowers to be delivered to the church on the day of the parade. If you plan on having fresh flowers, and choose not to use the selected florist, please do not bring them with you, because there will be no place to keep them fresh.

## HUNTINGDON COUNTY FIRE CONVENTION FIRE QUEEN PAGEANT 2007

### RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTESTANTS FIRE COMPANY

1. Responsible for registering contestants with the host company by June 18, 2007.
2. Providing transportation to and from the convention.
3. Providing a car for the contestant to ride on through the parade. **NO CONTESTANT IS PERMITTED TO RIDE ON THE APPARATUS DUE TO INSURANCE LIABILITES.**
4. Provide signs identifying contestant's company in the parade.
5. Provide sash or banner identifying company she represents.
6. Provide flowers for the contestant to carry during the parade and pageant.

### GENERAL RULES FOR THE CONTESTANTS

1. Must be 16 - 18 years of age by June 18, 2007. Must not be older than 18 years of age to compete in Central District's contest held in August.
2. Must be single, never married and have no children.
3. Must live in the service area she represents.
4. Will register with the pageant committee on July 14, 2007 from 12:30 - 1:00 p.m. Parents and friends are not permitted to accompany contestant during the interview or the luncheon. All parents and friends must leave the area after the contestant signs in.

### INTERVIEW

1. Will be interviewed by a panel of three (3) judges.
2. Should wear casual clothing, suitable for a church service or special event.
3. Will be asked questions from your personal information sheet, and random questions.
4. Queens must wear a sash or banner at all times (interviews, parade, pageant)
5. While not being judged, contestants will remain with the group.
6. At no time will any contestants leave the designated are. Any contestant who leaves and is unaccounted for at any time will be **disqualified!! NO EXCEPTIONS WILL MADE!!!!**

### LUNCHEON

1. Contestants will be served light refreshments during the interviews and before getting ready for the parade.

### Dressing and Parade:

1. Contestants will have 1-2 hours to dress and prepare for the evening between the luncheon and the parade.
2. No one will be permitted into the dressing area with the contestant until 4:00 p.m. **Only one person is permitted to assist with dressing contestant, and must leave by 5:00 p.m.**
3. Contestants should be picked up at the Singer's Gap Church by 5:00 for parade lineup.
4. When leaving the church, contestants should take all personal property with them. No one will be permitted back into the church after the parade or pageant.
5. While leaving the church, you will be asked to vote for Miss Congeniality. The box will be placed at the door going out of the building. **(VOTE ONLY ONCE.)**
6. All contestants will ride on a car with signs stating their name and the company she represents.
7. No contestants are permitted to ride on apparatus.
8. Contestants will line up in the parade with their respective company.
9. Contestant should carry flowers during the parade and pageant. These will be supplied by the company she represents.
10. Contestants will be judged during the parade.
11. Following the parade, contestants will report the stage at the Mount Union Area High School, and wait for the pageant to follow. No contestant will be permitted to leave the area. **If the contestants are not accounted for at any point and time they will be DISQUALIFIED!!**

### Pageant:

1. Girls will be introduced on stage in order by company.
2. Girls will be asked questions from their personal information sheet.
3. Girls will select a random question and be given ample time to answer.
4. Girls will be judged on poise, personality, posture, speaking ability, appropriateness of answer, smile, appearance, eye contact, etc.
5. A winner and one runner up will be named along with Miss Congeniality.
6. The runner will take the place of the queen in the event that she is unable to compete at Central Districts, or fulfill her year long reign.
